## **Long Beach Transit Announces Exciting Summer Services** *Museum Express and Water Taxis are Back for the Summer*

LONG BEACH, CALIF. (May 16, 2014) – Long Beach Transit announces its popular summer services. The AquaLink and AquaBus water taxis connect residents and tourists to attractions and restaurants along Long Beach's waterfront, and the Museum Express takes you to cultural hotspots in the Los Angeles and Orange County areas.

**Museum Express** gives residents the opportunity to travel to well-known, often nationally-acclaimed, museums and gardens for only \$8 on a comfortable, air conditioned Long Beach Transit bus. Destinations include the Getty Center, Griffith Park Observatory, The Huntington and many others. New to the schedule this year is the South Coast Botanic Gardens. The program operates June 19 through August 17, 2014. Over-the-counter sales begin May 29 at the downtown Transit and Visitor Information Center at 130 E. 1<sup>st</sup> Street on the southeast corner of 1<sup>st</sup> and Pine.

**AquaLink and AquaBus Water Taxis** are back on the water seven days a week from May 24 through September 1, 2014. LBT will be extending the length of the season with limited service available September 5 – October 26, 2014. AquaBus service is \$1 one way and connects customers to popular downtown attractions like The Queen Mary, Hotel Maya, Aquarium of the Pacific, Pine Avenue Circle and Shoreline Village. AquaLink service is \$5 one way and connects The Queen Mary and Aquarium visitors to eastside ocean-front destinations like the Belmont Pier and Alamitos Bay Landing.

"We're excited that summer is right around the corner and we can offer two exciting ways to enjoy fun activities while leaving your car at home. Whether you want some family fun on one of LBT's water taxis or take in some fine art and culture on our Museum Express bus, you'll have a great experience at a great price. We'll see you out on the water or in the museums," says new Long Beach Transit Deputy Chief Executive Officer, Debra Johnson.

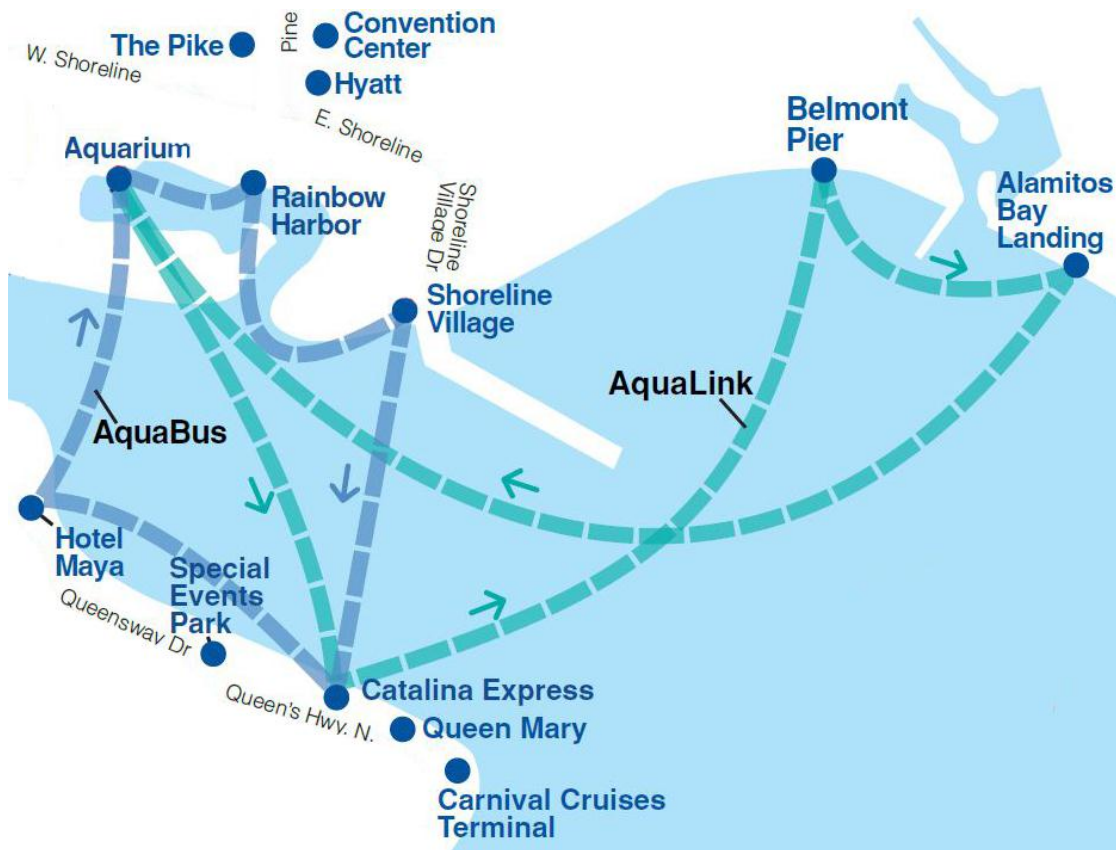
